

MARKET MACHINATIONS
Friday 27th September 2019
STORE

- Numbers fell by 48% to 3573 head of mixed quality cattle.
- Cattle were drawn from the central west, Warrego and Maranoa in a market where light cattle fell and heavy cattle lifted.
- Steers under 280kgs sold to 294c, the bulk from 230 to 275c.
- Steers from 280 - 400kgs ere 4-5c dearer topping at 296c, most from 250 to 287c.
- Feeders regained last week's fall to sell to 298c and average 276c.
- Heifers under 280kgs topped at 252c (sold by Rob & Kay Thorne) though most struggled to sell from 160 - 214.
- Heifers from 280 - 450kgs reached 260c to be firm to 5c dearer most making from 200 - 240c.
- Processors brought suitable heifers from 220 – 260c with some Victorian competition.
- Cows were firm to a shade dearer the best reaching 228c, most from 190 - 220c.
- Medium weight and 3 score cows sold from 170 to 200c.
- Store cows were 10c dearer with a new player to sell from 130 to 176c.



PRIME

- Numbers fell by just over 300 head to 579 mixed quality cattle.
- All the usual processors were in attendance and operating in a market that was 3-7c cheaper.
- Steers and bullocks sold to 316c, most from 265 – 286c for the US and plainer end, the best HGP types from 290 – 310c.
- Heifers topped at 286c, most selling from 230 – 256c.
- Heavy prime cows reached 228c, most making from 195-220c.
- Medium weight and 3 score cows sold to 216c, the bulk from 180-205c.
- Lightweight and light conditioned cows sold from 120-170c.
- Bulls topped at 288c with live exporters strong on suitable types.

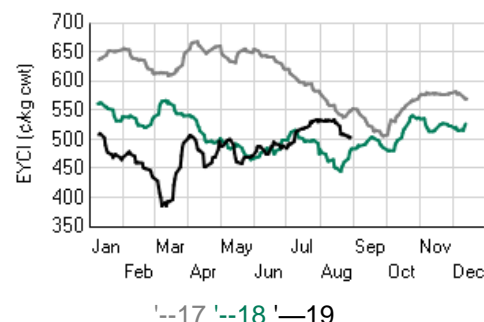
